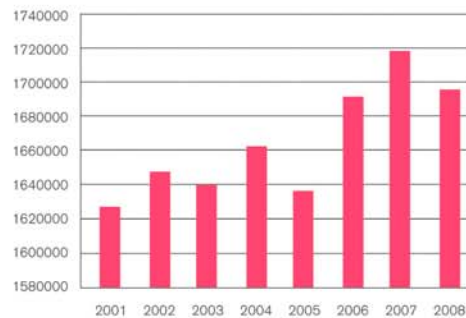
Developing a sustainable Campus for the future

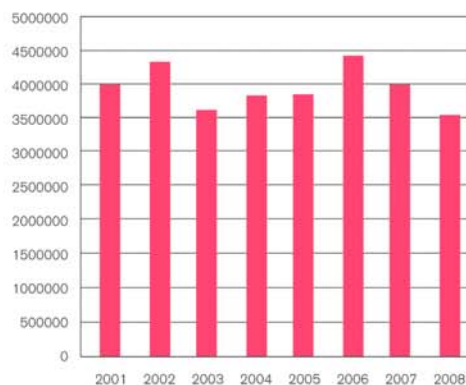
As we plan further re-development of the ISB Campus, the school remains deeply committed to the values of sustainability and respect for the environment.
